"They want me to head up a publicity office for the Union Pacific, you know, write books and pamphlets that will bring people west. What an offer, Dell."


"That's wonderful." I gazed at the table I'd had built. Too large for the space, I could see that now.

And the pool of congealed blood beneath it







Henry snapped his head up at that. "He is a worthless, no good, cheating scoundrel."


"He's our father's cousin. They were business partners...until Uncle Tristram disappeared with everything our father worked to build."
