Jack stared back, trying to cover his shock.

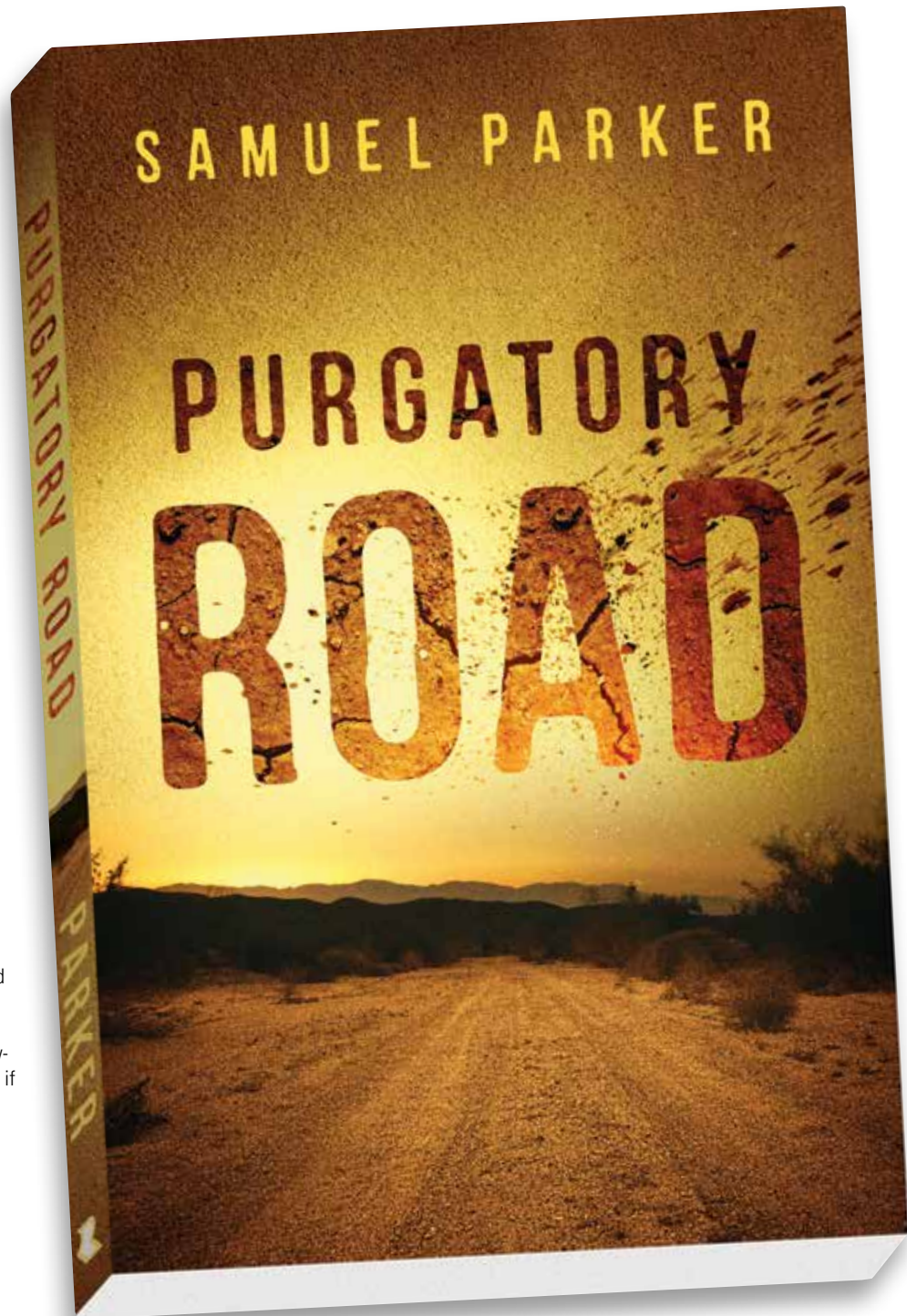
"Your name's on your card."

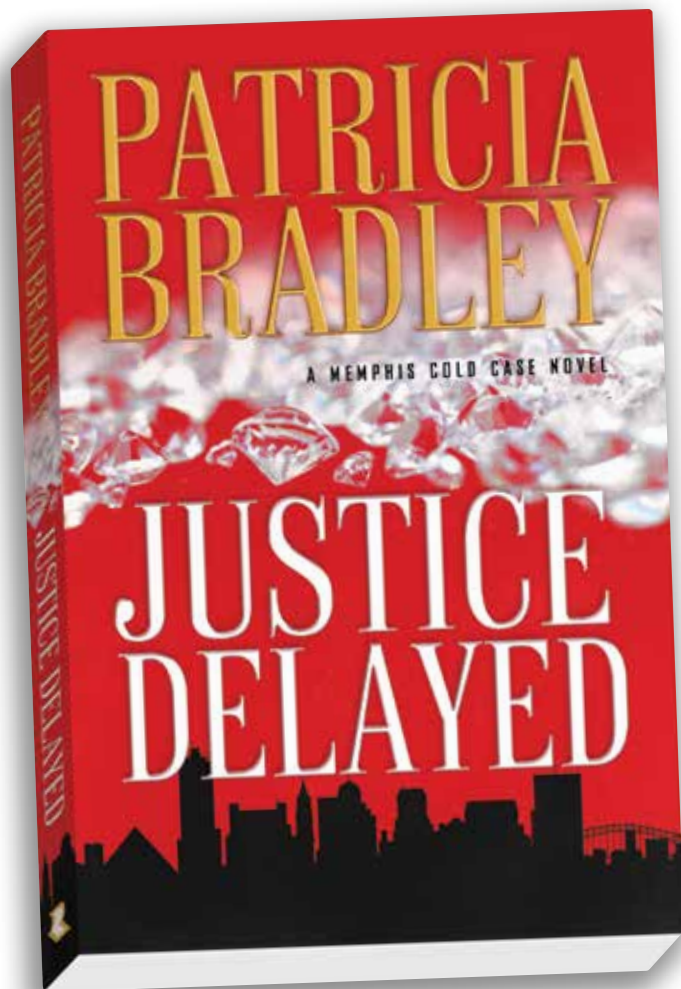

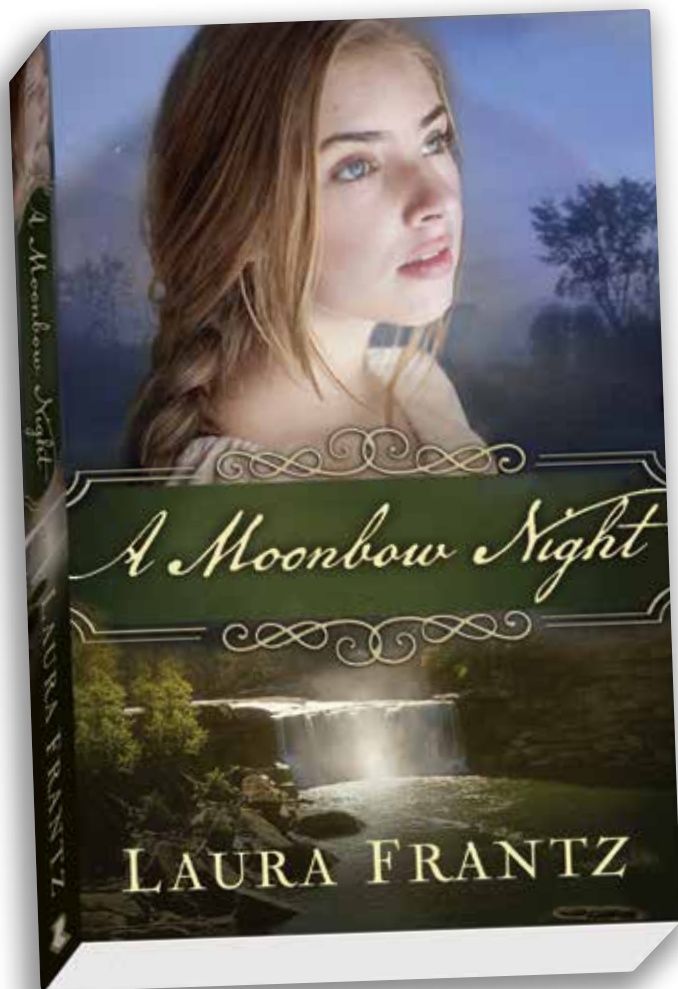

"Y'think I was t'blame for the quarrel, dinnae ya?"

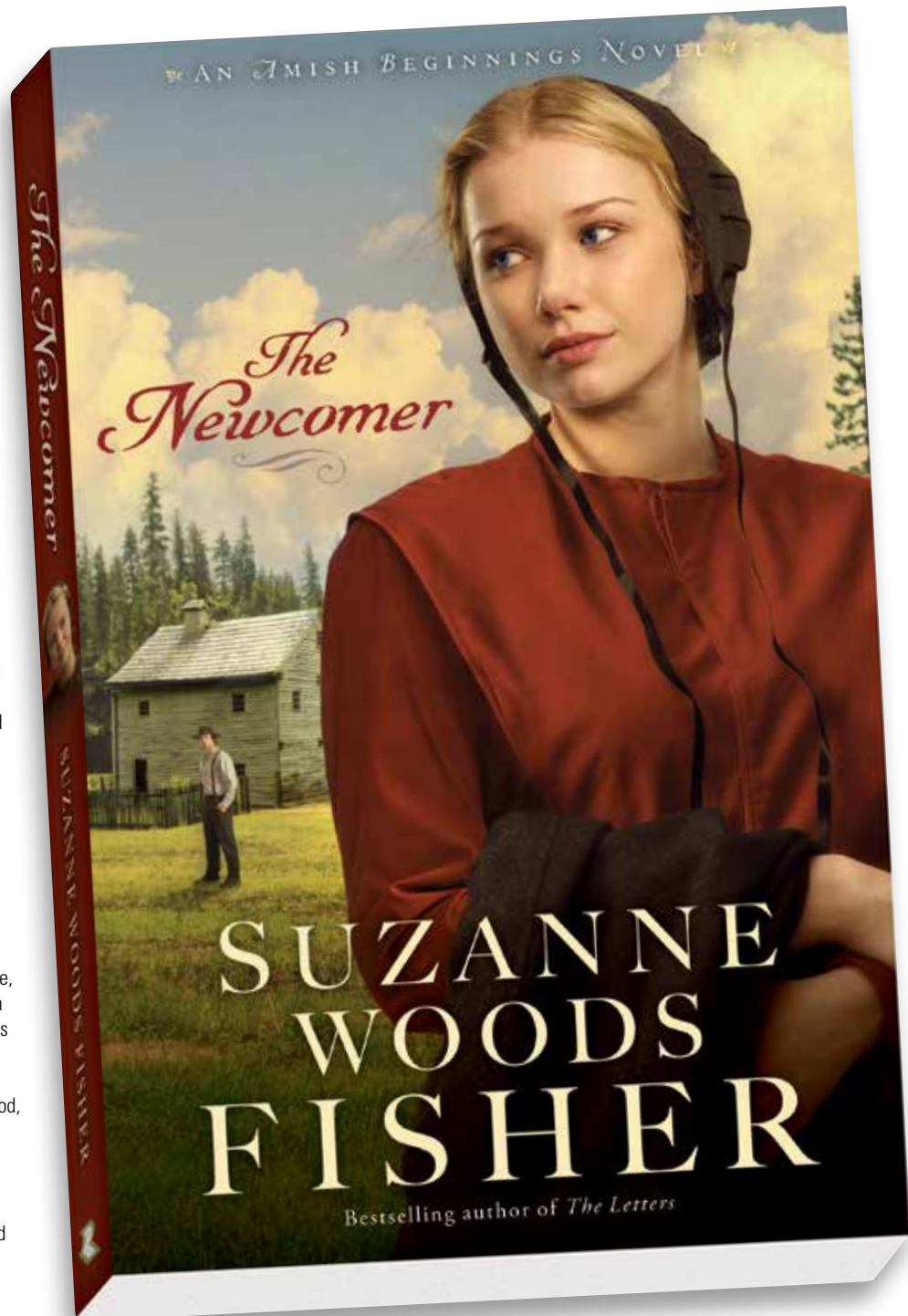
"Truly, I don't know." Who was to blame for the quarrel seemed far less important to her than the anger that flared between them. In that moment they were no longer father and son, but strangers.

"Well, that's not what I was hoping to hear."

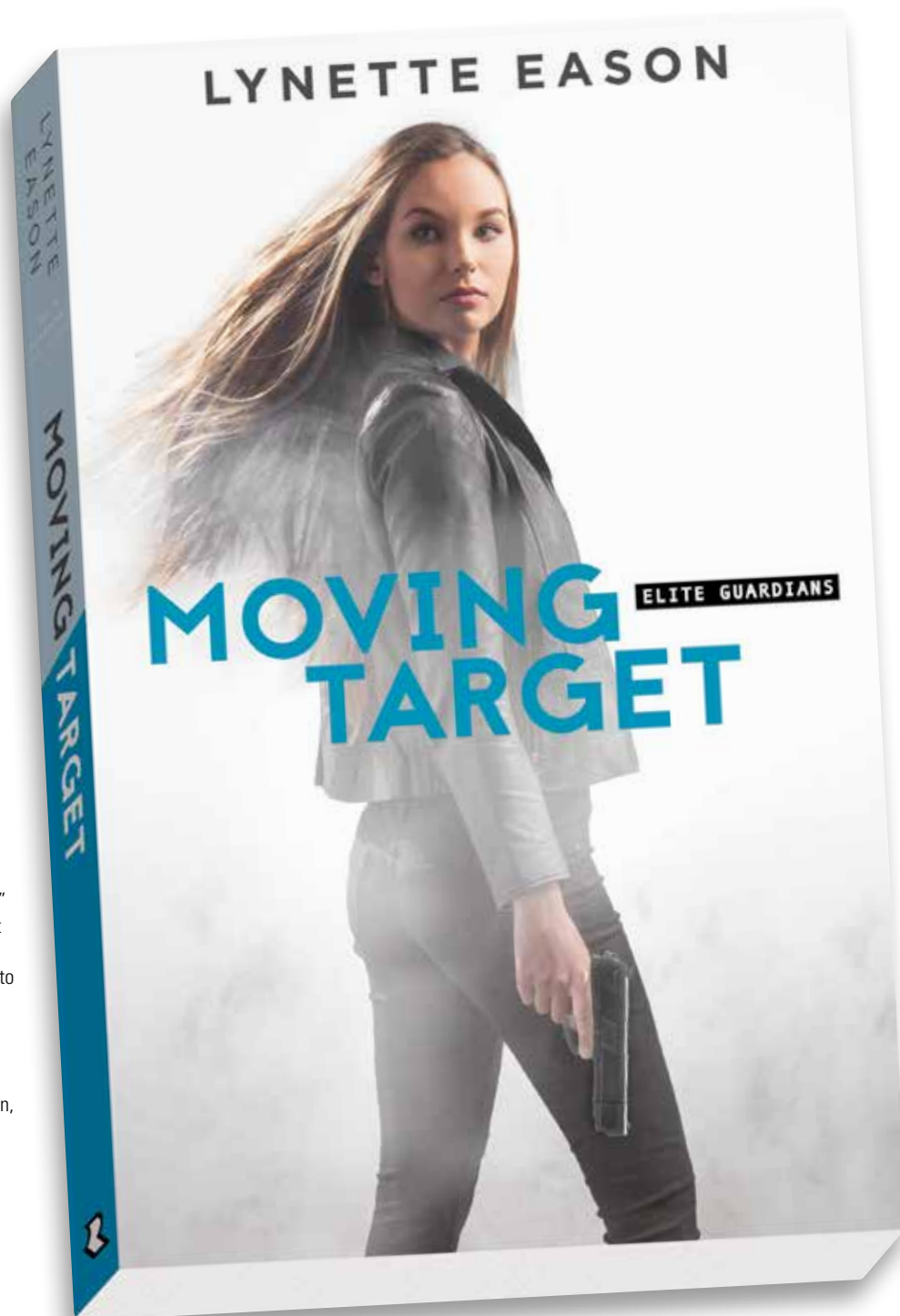
Wary, she eyed him. "What do you mean?"

Maybe if he let her in, just a little, they might get to that deeper place, stir something back to life . . . "I thought I was going to die tonight."

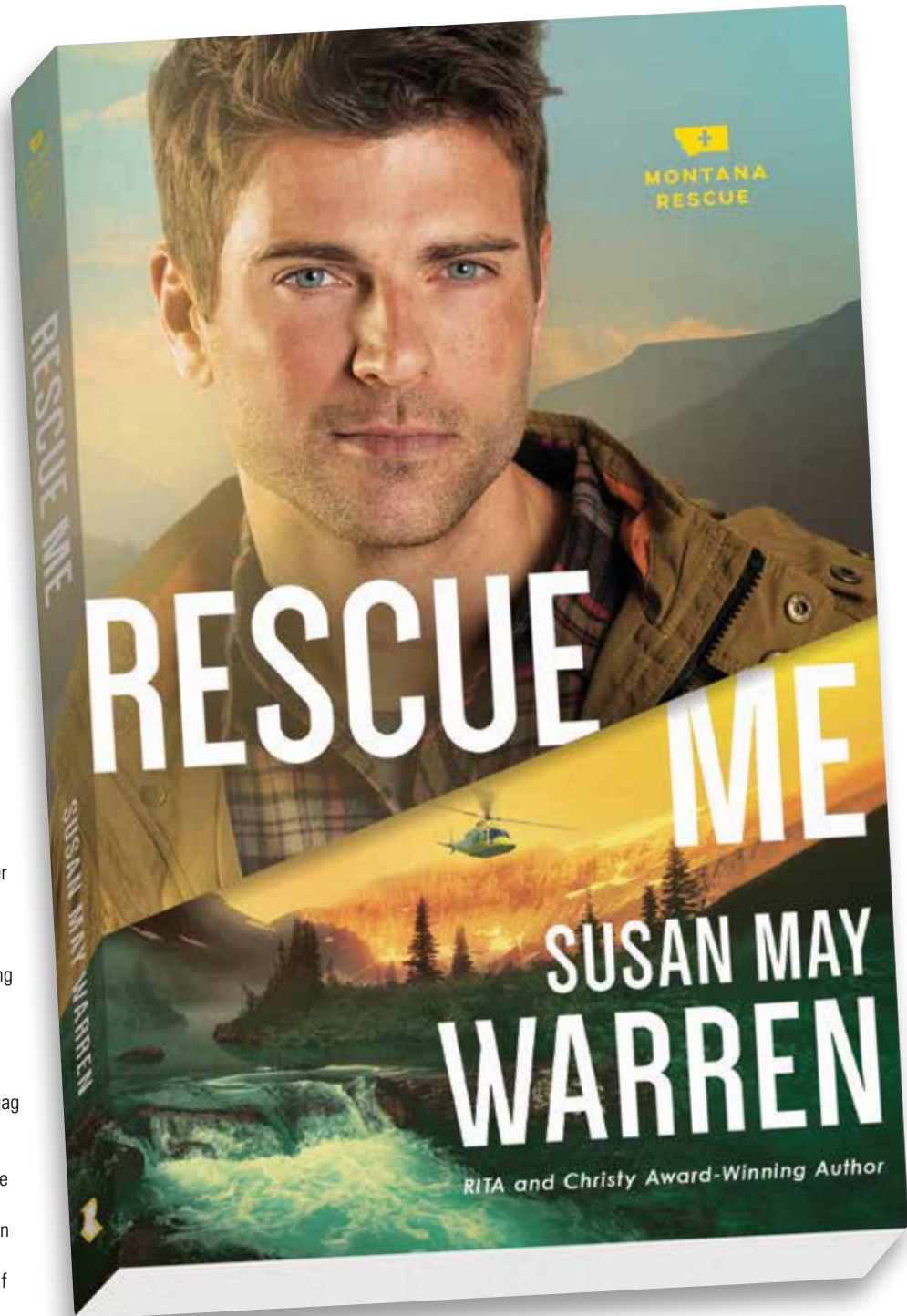

"Hmm. That surprises me, seeing as how this is his second hit."

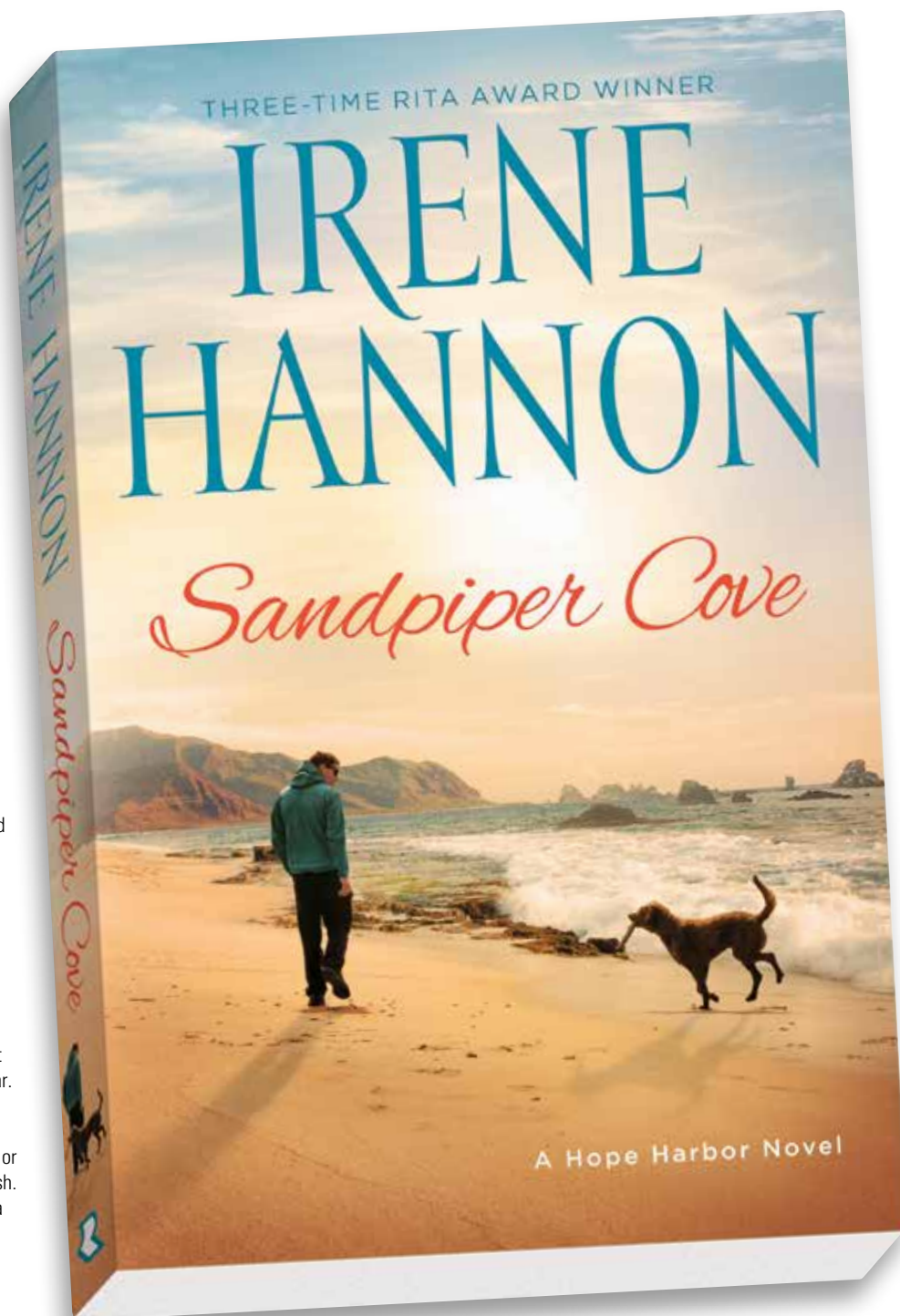
There'd been two incidents of unreported vandalism inside the town limits?
