
Vision is a defining characteristic of successful leadership, and yet many leaders deem it secondary. They limit leadership to execution. It's right there in the word: *executive*. But it's only part of the picture. Without a destination and people to follow you there, you might be busy, but you're not busy leading.

Despite the need, I hear from leaders that they don't have either time or skills to establish a vision or sell it to their team. They're missing out on massive benefits. Start with the fact that vision drives execution. Why? Because you're able to align all of your resources, your focus, and your strategy around that vision. Properly aligned, your organization avoids the sideways energy and wasted resources spent by people pursuing projects that are outside the scope of your vision.

By minimizing or even eliminating the cross-purpose activities within your company, vision allows you to scale much faster than you would otherwise be able. By contrast, if you're unclear about your destination, your future will be a hit-or-miss prospect at best. Without a vision guiding the direction of your organization, the tendency will be to make small, incremental decisions leading to any number of outcomes—not all of which are favorable.

I love how baseball legend and part-time philosopher Yogi Berra put it: "If you don't know where you're going, you might not get there." A better way to express that sentiment would be: Your company will end up somewhere. Wouldn't it be better to end up somewhere desirable and on purpose?

Finally, don't overlook the role vision plays in giving meaning to your team. The right vision inspires people across the organization by stirring within them the motivation to follow and do great things together. Vision reminds people what we're building and why it matters. That's what happened at NASA after Kennedy cast his vision to put a man on the moon. According to one report, "a strong connection between a NASA employees' day-to-day role and the ultimate goal" was forged, evidenced by the comments of one custodian. "I'm not mopping floors," he said, "I'm putting a man on the moon."

A certain ruler asked him, "Good teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?"

"Why do you call me good?" Jesus answered. "*No one is good—except God alone.*"

(Luke 18:18–19, italics mine again, but I bet Jesus wanted it italicized.)

This is very hard for us to accept. "*I'm not a good person*" may be the single most shockingly counter-cultural thing a person can say.

It almost sounds crazy to say it. "Hello. My name is Brant, and I am not a good guy."

Not only is it countercultural, it even runs counter to our physiology. Studies have shown we actually get a dopamine hit when we think we're proven right. We can literally become addicted to the sensation of our rightness. "Your body does not discriminate against pleasure," writes clinical psychologist Renee Carr. "It can become addicted to any activity or substance that consistently produces dopamine."


This might explain why we spend time scrolling and enjoying information and news links that prove—once again—how right we are. Wow, do we love this feeling. This also might explain why many have gone to their graves insisting they were right, even if it made them miserable in the process. Addictions work that way.

W. H. Auden was right: "We'd rather be ruined than changed."

Jesus is relentless on this, because He knew that *self-righteousness could separate us from God forever*. We're all sick with this, and if we don't submit to His healing, it's terminal.

Listen to Jesus, and it sounds like an intervention, except instead of a group of people surrounding an unbelieving addict, it's the crowd that needs to get the message, and just one man is delivering it.

Interventions like that, historically, don't end well for the message-bearer. Calling out our self-righteousness isn't popular, and believe me, this isn't lost on me as I'm writing this. (Note to self: Next time, use a pen name. Pick something cooler than Brant Hansen.)


That's why the good life isn't *something* you find, it's *someone* you become.

In a terrified voice she cried out, "Are you Pastor Matthew?"


Nervously I responded, "Yes."
