Brought to life with numerous images, this book shows how the example of the earliest Christians can offer today's believers encouragement and hope.

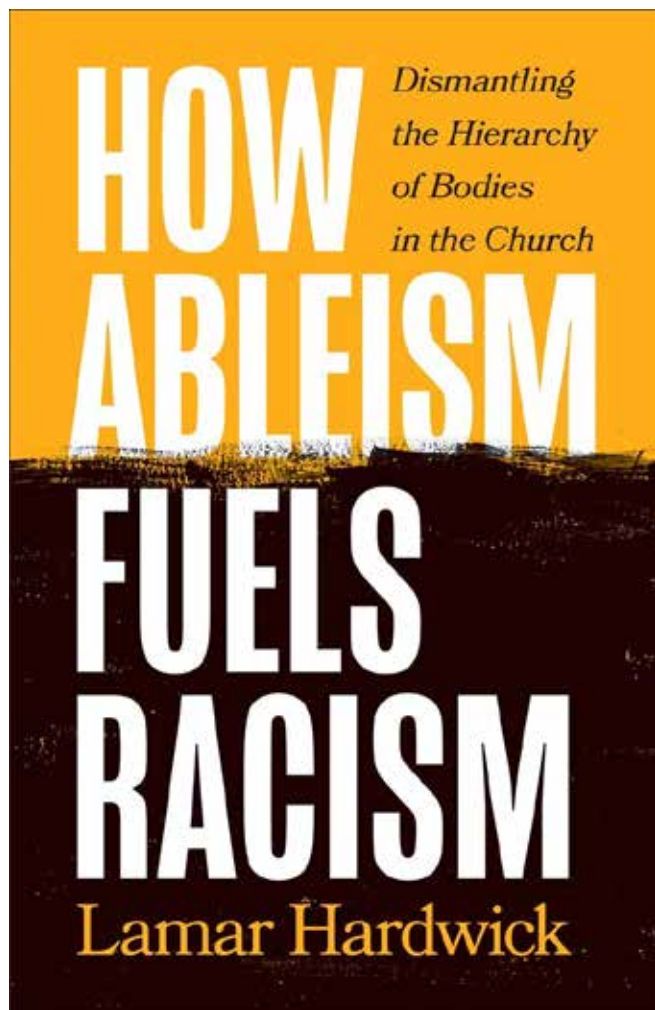
