As our bodies baked in the open sea we began to realize that the sun was changing from friend to foe. It soon blistered our previously chilled flesh. We tore our clothing to make protective hoods for shade, but the ultraviolet rays reflecting off the water still managed to find our skin. Late that first day, around dusk, we had company. To our horror, we began seeing large, black dorsal fins cutting through the water and circling our group. I cannot describe the fear.
