




Tragically, Selena and I have talked with many couples who are facing hardship because of riskless, fruitless vulnerability or a lack of vulnerability altogether.

One couple comes to mind where the wife has admitted “falling out of love” with her husband, yet she refuses to re-engage with him as a means to sanctifying her incorrect heart-posture. For whatever reason, her heart is hard and her mind is made up. When challenged in her thinking, she insists that what they once had has been lost, and that no number of loving actions can rekindle her emotional desire to be with her husband.

I’m also reminded of the wife whose husband is addicted to pornography and has been for more than a decade. He is candidly open with his sin, and even though he knows it hurts his wife, he sees little value in changing his behavior or getting outside help. When she urges him, he admits that he fundamentally doesn’t want to change or see the need. His words are authentic, but his heart is hard. What sort of fruit will that type of “vulnerability” produce? Certainly not righteousness, and definitely not closeness in his marriage.

Finally, I remember Jack and Hannah, who after being married for three years, ended their relationship abruptly. As was later discovered, Jack had been going through a years-long, silent crisis of faith. His quiet doubts finally mounted to the point where he simply walked away from God, Hannah, and their church all at once. All of it happened while they attended a small group at their church with others they considered close friends. However, hidden in the dark, Jack’s doubts festered and grew without chance of being truly known or helped by those around him, namely Hannah. Neither she nor their community saw Jack’s exit coming until it was too late.

In the above cases, each couple had built a marriage culture deficient of meaningful risk. There was a semblance of vulnerability but it lacked power without a deep desire for fellowship and holiness that would lead to sanctification.

Monsters aren't real. As reasonable adults, we know this. But we also know that, while fake, the monsters of fairy tales, movies, and Netflix series embody our very real fears. Large, powerful beings that hunt us in the dark make us feel small, weak, vulnerable. When characters in these stories run away, they temporarily feel safe, but it's not until the monster is faced head-on that the story can have a happy ending—and, more importantly, the hero can become all he or she was created to be.

The same is true of the monsters of the spiritual life. The monsters of comparison (I am what others say about me), more (I am what I have), and success (I am what I do) are powerful enemies of a healthy spiritual life. But ignoring them solves nothing. Pastor and speaker Luke Norsworthy wants you to face your monsters, get to know them, and discover how they are inviting you into a deeper understanding of yourself and a more intimate connection with God. You'll never completely eradicate your fears, but if you befriend them, they can lead you into becoming God's intention for you.



My own father thought I was an awesome young man. He told everybody. There was only one problem—he never told me. All the way into my late twenties, I believed my dad didn't really like being with me.

Many parents think their kids are downright amazing, and they spend a lot of time talking them up to other people. But for your son to know and believe it's true, you're going to have to do more than tell your friends how awesome you think he is.

There's no rational way to kill your career. This is my last thought before walking from the shadows of the ABC headquarters' red-brick façade. But after six years, hundreds of interviews, countless hours hosting the weekend edition of *Good Morning America (GMA)*, and taking my seat at *The View*, it's time. I'm ready to pull the trigger, and if I don't, I know my addiction will get the best of me. . . .

I glance at my notepad one last time, take stock of the bullet points. How forceful can I be? What if I say it all wrong? What if I'm too much? I imagine the headline: "Paula Faris Kills Career over Burger and Fries." James Goldston (president of ABC News) already knows my struggles, my needs, even my demands. We're a part of the ABC family, and for better or worse, it's the kind of family that doesn't keep secrets well (after all, journalists make names off outing other people's secrets). But he wants to hear it straight from the horse's mouth.

"James, if ABC wants me to stay, I need to walk away from *The View* and the weekend desk at *GMA*. The Wednesday through Sunday schedule is killing me. It's starting to affect my marriage. It's keeping me from my kids, and I don't think God's calling me to sacrifice my family for my career."

He nods but says nothing.



This is a call to follow the fears and frustration to the unknown, frightening places inside. This is a call to uncover. We must stay. Stay with the pain. Stay with the anger. Stay with the joy. Stay with the apathy. Stay with the funk and unexplainable feelings. We must stay with the fog. We must feel it heavy on our faces, damp and eerie and dense. We must let the truth of our hearts rise to the surface and accept those wobbly places within us. This is the process of finding words for the places in our past that we never grieved, the feelings that were never fully felt, the sadness that never lessened, the loneliness in marriage we never imagined, or the rejection that rebuffs us over and over and over again.
