

6. One theme throughout your book is the concept of God's "invisibility cloak," as you call it. Can you explain a bit about why God must remain invisible?
7. *Finding God in the Bible* is—ultimately—a book about friendship with God. You repeatedly write that this is the main point of the entire Bible. Can you expound on this a little?
8. You say that friendship is ultimately about trust. How does this concept of trust appear in Scripture?
9. In your book, you look at the lives of many different Biblical characters in very unique, often humorous ways. What was your approach in writing about people like Abraham, Moses, David and even Jesus?
10. Has writing a book about the Bible affected what your favorite Bible verse is?
11. What do you hope people will take away from their experience of reading *Finding God in the Bible*?
